TO FILE AN APPEAL
FROM CHANGE OF
ASSESSMENT NOTICE**

All of Washington County's 121,000 separate parcels of real property are presently the subject of a court-ordered real estate tax reassessment. Preliminary reassessments were mailed to real estate owners beginning in March 2016.

The final Change of Assessment Notices should be mailed out on or about July 1, 2016. If the real estate owner is dissatisfied with the new tax assessment, an appeal must be filed **within 40 days** of receipt of the Change of Assessment Notice.

The new tax assessments – and the real estate taxes on commercial and industrial property – are expected to increase.




